Rick brought in his Tamiya 48th scale II-2M3.





- Two Best of Show awards (Automotive and Non-Automotive (Military/Sci-Fi/Figure/etc.)
- Previous models having placed First (Gold) or Best of Show are not eligible to compete
- Entries will be checked for proper category placement and moved, as necessary, before judging
- Models requiring more than 4 sq ft and/or weighing more than 30lbs may not be allowed to enter based upon available space. Please contact us before bringing the model
- Junior entries are FREE to register
- Reasonable care and protection will be provided for entries by the Hosts and the Judges; however, Hosts cannot assume responsibility in the event of loss or damage


