Les Young brought in a fascinating new magnify glasses headset that can be picked up for \$22.00. Highly recommended.










Kit Review

Phil Secard brought in Resin Space Marine.






Mike F brought in a Hobby Boss72nd scale (of course!) Nike II missile.






