Interesting Article - Review Corps.

IPMS/USA has within the organization a Review Corp. consisting of volunteer members who provide reviews of products obtained by kit manufacturers and publishing companies. By joining this review corp one can bid on products even before they are brought to the market. Below are two messages explaining the review process. All books and kits are free to the first bidder and as long as a "Review" is written and pictures taken. A great way to obtain the latest kits and books.

Participation in the Reviewers' Corps process is open to any active IPMS/USA Member in good standing.

If a member wishes to participate in the Corps, he or she should review the attached document, and if he or she is able to comply with the guidelines, they need to send me send me an email acknowledging that, and providing current contact information including a valid shipping address. (guidelines to be sent via email request). They can then be added to the distribution list in Dropbox maintained by Phil Peterson, and can "bid" on new review items as he posts them. That's about all there is to it. We start new reviewers out with no more than 1-2 items until they have established a cadence and reliability with us, then it's anything you want assuming you maintain your backlog of review products.

As for manufacturers we get them from all over, Tamiya, MENG, MRC, Italeri, Airfix, Special Hobby, etc. We also get lots of books from Casemate, Mushroom Models, Osprey, David Doyle, etc. Then there are decals and aftermarket items. Whenever a shipment comes into me I add them to the Dropbox list and send an email out to the Corp then it is first come first served. Some guys are quick to respond but I try to be fair and spread the wealth when I can.

We also have been getting a lot of stuff from new, smaller companies from all over the globe so the list can be very interesting at times.

Hopefully several of your club will be interested to join the gang. You can give them firsthand experience on how it functions.



Techniques

Tire – Rubber – Weathering

The technique consists of using two pigments and a soft fluffy brush. Start by mixing a 50:50 mix of Natural Iron Oxide pigment (Vallejo 73.115 with Light Yellow Ochre 73.102) pigment. Lightly brush on the pigments with the soft fluffy brush until the desired appearance is achieved. I wanted a natural used finish and I believe I was able to achieve this look. Other appearance could be achieved with different combinations of pigments. Apply a light coat of clear flat finish to protect the tires. Depending on the appearance, another light coat of clear could be applied since the flat clear tends to turn light pigments almost transparent.




