  - Primary Takeaways
    - Warm the water for decal immersion. Rick uses a coffee cup warmer.
    - Roll out any residual water with a Q-Tip or like device.
    - Don't use any special adhesives or decal solvents unless absolutely necessary so to allow you to rehydrate the decal, with water, if your placement isn't where you want it.

- Air drying is the best, however, using a hair dryer will do in a pinch.
- If you have air bubbles, pierce the decal with a sharp device and either flood with water or a solvent if necessary.




